Sec. 2 Ray Berglund State Scenic Memorial Wayside. Pursuant to the conditions contained in said deed, the said lands are hereby dedicated to perpetual use of the people as a state scenic wayside known as Ray Berglund State Scenic Memorial Wayside.

CHAPTER 208—H. F. No. 529

An act relating to the purchase of cloth for uniforms of deputy sheriffs by the board of county commissioners in certain counties having an area of more than 5000 square miles and a population of more than 150,000.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Deputy sheriffs' uniforms; St. Louis County. In any county of this State now or hereafter having an area in excess of 5000 square miles and a population of more than 150,000, the Board of County Commissioners may appropriate money and authorize the purchase of cloth for uniforms for such deputies as the sheriff may designate.
