

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 98.52, Subdivision 3, is hereby amended to read as follows:

98.52 Subd. 3. Where, in his opinion, the public welfare will not be injured, the commissioner may reinstate the following types of licenses which have become null and void by operation of subdivision 1, provided such authority to reinstate shall not extend to persons who have been so convicted during the preceding three year period:

(1) To maintain and operate fur and game farms or private fish hatcheries;

(2) To take fish commercially in Lake of the Woods, Rainy Lake, Namakan Lake, or Lake Superior;

(3) To buy fish from licensed commercial fishermen in Lake of the Woods, Rainy Lake, Namakan Lake, or Lake Superior;

(4) *To sell live minnows.*

#### CHAPTER 210—H. F. No. 583

*An act relating to wild animals and the taking of sturgeon in the tributaries of the St. Croix boundary waters; amending Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 101.41, Subdivision 1.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 101.41, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

101.41 **Seasons and limits.** Subdivision 1. Rock or lake sturgeon, shovelnose sturgeon or hackleback, spoonbill, or paddlefish, may not be taken, bought, sold, transported or possessed at any time except as may be specifically provided by order of the commissioner for boundary waters, *provided*

*that regulations applicable to the St. Croix boundary waters shall apply equally to the tributaries thereof.*

CHAPTER 211—H. F. No. 665

*An act relating to motor vehicles, providing for the regulation and taxation thereof; amending Minnesota Statutes 1949, Sections 168.10, and 168.36.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 168.10, Subdivision 1, is amended to read as follows:

**168.10 Registration. Subdivision 1. Application.** Every owner of any motor vehicle in this state, not exempted by section 168.012 or section 168.26, shall as soon as he shall become the owner thereof and thereafter during the period October 1 to December 31 each year, both dates inclusive, file with the registrar on a blank provided by him, a listing for taxation and application for the registration of such vehicle, stating the name and address of the owner, the name and address of the person from whom purchased, *make* of motor vehicle, year and number of the model, *manufacturer's identification number* and *serial number*, type of body, the weight of the vehicle in pounds, *for trailers only*, its rated load carrying capacity *and for buses only*, its seating capacity, and such other information as the registrar may require. The owner shall make an oath or affirmation before some officer authorized by law to administer oaths or affirmations that the statements made are correct and true; and any false statement wilfully and knowingly made in regard thereto shall be deemed perjury and punished accordingly. Such listing for taxation and application for registration need not be sworn to when the applicant is listing the same vehicle for taxation and registration for the second or any succeeding time, *unless he elects to pay registration tax thereon for a different gross weight or carrying capacity than for the previous registration.* The listing and application for registration by dealers or manufacturers' agents within the state, of motor
