An act relating to the municipal court of the city of Minneapolis; amending Laws 1913, Chapter 424, Section 5, as amended by Laws 1923, Chapter 413, Section 2, as amended by Laws 1937, Chapter 273, Section 5, as amended by Laws 1945, Chapter 387, Section 1, as amended by Laws 1949, Chapter 322, Section 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1913, Chapter 424, Section 5, as amended by Laws 1923, Chapter 413, Section 2, as amended by Laws 1937, Chapter 273, Section 5, as amended by Laws 1945, Chapter 387, Section 1, as amended by Laws 1949, Chapter 322, Section 1, is amended to read:

Sec. 5. [Subdivision 1.] Minneapolis Municipal Court; salary of probation officer. Such probation officer shall receive as full compensation for his services, \$4,000 per annum; the assistant probation officer, \$3,400 per annum; and each deputy such amount as shall be fixed by the judges of said court; not exceeding \$3,100 per annum. Such salary shall be payable in equal semi-monthly installments out of the city treasury.

Subdivision 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Subdivision 1, commencing as of January 1, 1951, and continuing until May 1, 1953, the salaries of the employees enumerated in Subdivision 1 shall be \$400.00 per year in addition to the salary for each such employee, payable in the same manner as provided therein.
