

100.27 Subd. 2. Deer and moose may be taken in such areas of the state, under such restrictions and on such dates within the periods hereafter prescribed as the commissioner may, by order, provide:

(1) Deer, by bow and arrow only, *between October 1st and October 31st*;

(2) Deer, by legal firearms and with bow and arrow, for not more than nine days, between November 10th and December 1st;

(3) One antlered moose or one deer, or both, in the Northwest Angle only, between October 10th and October 20th, or one antlered moose in an area not to exceed three miles wide paralleling the Canadian Border to be designated by the commissioner, but at the same time as the season for taking deer.

CHAPTER 362—H. F. No. 839

An act relating to registration lists for voters and extending the period for removing names of persons who do not vote; amending Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 201.19.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 201.19, is amended to read:

201.19 **Registration list checked.** At the close of each calendar year the commissioner shall check the registration list for the purpose of eliminating excess names; and, to that end, shall examine the election registers and whenever it appears that a registered voter has not voted at an election at least *once in two consecutive calendar years in any city of the first class of over 90,000 and less than 200,000 inhabitants or in a city of over 450,000 inhabitants, and once in four consecutive calendar years elsewhere in the state* his card shall be taken from the original and duplicate registration

lists and destroyed, and a printed postal card notice of these facts, and that the voter must reregister in order to vote in the district at any ensuing election, shall be sent to the last known address of the voter.

CHAPTER 363—H. F. No. 919

An act relating to highway traffic regulation and amending Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 169.18, Subdivision 8.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 169.18, Subdivision 8, is amended to read as follows:

169.18 Subd. 8. **Following vehicle too closely.** (a) The driver of a motor vehicle shall not follow another vehicle more closely than is reasonable and prudent, having due regard for the speed of such vehicles and the traffic upon and the conditions of the highway.

(b) The driver of any motor vehicle drawing another vehicle, or the driver of any motor truck, when traveling upon a roadway outside of a business or residence district, shall not follow within 500 feet of another vehicle. The provisions of this clause shall not be construed to prevent overtaking and passing nor shall the same apply upon any lane specially designated for use by motor trucks.

CHAPTER 364—H. F. No. 1069
