

## CHAPTER 464—S. F. No. 703

*An act relating to police pensions and benefits in cities of the second class; amending Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 423.201.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 423.201, is amended to read as follows:

423.201. **Pensions and benefits, payment.** *All service, disability and dependency pensions and benefits heretofore allowed by any such relief association shall hereafter be paid in amounts provided for in sections 423.13 and 423.155.*

Sec. 2. This act shall be effective on the first day of the month next following the date of its enactment.

CHAPTER 465—S. F. No. 758

[Sections 2 to 12 Coded as Sections 21.111 to 21.122]

*An act relating to the inspection and certification of seed potatoes; providing penalties.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 21.01, Subdivisions 14, 15, 16, 17; Sections 21.11 to 21.20, inclusive, are repealed.

[21.111] Sec. 2. **Definitions.** Subdivision 1. **Terms.** When used in this act the terms defined in this section shall have the meanings ascribed to them.

Subd. 2. **Inspected.** "Inspected" means that the potato plants are examined in the field and that the harvested potatoes produced by such plants are examined by the commissioner, or under his authority.
