

CHAPTER 475—H. F. No. 781

An act relating to qualifications of journeyman electricians; amending Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 326.26, Subdivision 3.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 326.26, Subdivision 3, is amended to read:

326.26 Subd. 3. **Journeyman electrician, qualification.** An applicant for a journeyman electrician's license shall furnish evidence, in writing, that he has had at least four years' experience in wiring for, installing, and repairing electrical apparatus and equipment for light, heat, and power; and shall pay an examination fee of \$3.00.

CHAPTER 476—H. F. No. 1234

An act relating to municipal courts in cities of the third class in any county having a population of not less than 50,000 nor more than 60,000 inhabitants; providing for fees and costs in certain criminal and civil cases.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Municipal court, fees.** In all proceedings had in the Municipal Court in any city of the third class in any county in this state now or hereafter having a population of not less than 50,000 nor more than 60,000 inhabitants, which municipal court is operating pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1949, Sections 488.26 to 488.29, inclusive, the following fees shall be charged and collected by the judge or clerk as and for the compensation of the judge, in lieu of the equivalent fee or item of cost provided for in Section 488.27, and such fees may be taxed in all cases where applicable, as follows:
