CHAPTER 251—H. F. No. 1106

An act relating to compensation of clerks of district court in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Clearwater county; clerk of district court, salary.** In all counties with a population according to the then last preceding federal census of not less than 10,000 nor more than 11,000 inhabitants with a taxable valuation of not less than \$2,000,000 nor more than \$3,000,000 the provisions of Laws 1951, Chapter 327 shall apply to the clerk of the district court and he shall receive the same salary increase as the other elective county officers of such county receive under the provisions of said act.
