CHAPTER 502-H. F. No. 1043

An act relating to the power of town supervisors to name streets, highways and other public ways in counties containing a city of the first class; giving the county board the right to name county roads; amending Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 366.021.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 366.021, is amended to read:

366.021 Additional powers and duties. The board of supervisors of any township situated in a county containing a city of the first class shall have authority by ordinance, resolution or by law to name and change the names of streets, avenues, roads, highways, alleys and other public places in said township other than county roads; and to declare and impose penalties and punishments for violation thereof.

CHAPTER 503-H. F. No. 1122

An act relating to the bureau of criminal apprehension; amending Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 626.34.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 626.34, is amended to read:

626.34 Employees, civil service; expenses and compensation. The superintendent is hereby authorized to appoint, in the manner provided, and to remove as provided by the state civil service law, and to prescribe the duties of such skilled and unskilled employees, including an identification expert, as may be necessary to carry out the work of the bureau; provided, that the appointment and removal of such skilled and unskilled employees shall be in the manner provided by the state civil service law. The superintendent and all officers and employees of the bureau shall, in addition to their compensation, receive their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties, provided that the total expense of the bureau during any year shall not exceed the appropriation therefor.
