Except as provided in subdivision 2, where an account, claim or demand against any county, county board of education for unorganized territory, school district, town or city of the second, third or fourth class, including any city with a home rule charter, or any park district, for any property or services can be itemized in the ordinary course of business, the board or officer authorized by law to audit and allow claims shall not audit or allow the claim until the person claiming payment, or his agent, reduces it to writing, in items, and signs a declaration to the effect that such account, claim, or demand is just and correct; that no part of such account, claim or demand has been paid.
