

same manner as are other employees of the county in which the city referred to in section 1 is located, and at a rate established by the district judges of the district in which he is employed.

Subd. 2. The law clerk may be removed from office at any time without cause for any reason by the judges of the district court for the district in which he is employed.

#### CHAPTER 322—S. F. No. 1130

*An act relating to the holding of general terms of the district court in the eighteenth judicial district; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 484.26.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 484.26, is amended to read:

**484.26 Eighteenth judicial district.** General terms of district court in the counties constituting the eighteenth judicial district shall be held each year at the times herein specified:

Anoka County: On the *fourth Tuesday in April* and the *fourth Tuesday in November*.

Isanti County: On the *first Tuesday in February* and the *first Tuesday in September*.

Sherburne County: On the *third Tuesday in February* and the *third Tuesday in September*.

Wright County: On the *fourth Tuesday in March* and the *fourth Tuesday in October*.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1956.
