

than 10,100 according to the 1950 federal census and operating under a home rule charter and holding a city election biennially, the board of park commissioners shall consist of six members who shall hold office for the period of six years from and after the date of their election and qualification and until their successors are duly elected and qualify, and in such cities changing from annual to biennial elections a sufficient number of members shall be elected at the first biennial election hereafter or following such change and for such terms to provide a full board of six members, with terms of two members expiring on the date of the first following election, the term of two members expiring on the date of the second following election and the term of two members expiring on the date of the third following election.

CHAPTER 383—H. F. No. 715

An act relating to the department of civil service, pertaining to salaries; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 43.08.
