than 16,000 according to the last federal census, containing not less than 16 nor more than 18 congressional townships, an area of less than 600 square miles, and a valuation in excess of \$12,000,000, the county auditor shall receive a salary of \$5,000 per annum.

## CHAPTER 398—S. F. No. 716

An act authorizing the sale of certain trust fund land. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. State to sell land in state forest. The following described real estate located in the county of Aitkin to-wit:

SW/4 NE/4 24 - 49 - 22, being state land located in a state forest may be withdrawn from the forest and sold in the same manner as other trust fund land, and the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 92.45, are not applicable thereto.

## CHAPTER 399—S. F. No. 1079

An act relating to highway traffic regulations; providing a limitation on the height of vehicles unladen or with load; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 169.81, Subdivision 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 169.81, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

169.81 Height and length limitation. Subdivision 1. Height. No vehicle unladen or with load shall exceed a height of 12 feet six inches, except that the height of unenclosed transport carriers used exclusively for hauling motor vehicles shall not exceed 13 feet six inches when loaded.
