CHAPTER 421-H. F. No. 1336

An act relating to a tax upon the sale of cigarettes and upon distributors thereof; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 297.01, Subdivision 5.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 297.01, Subdivision 5, is amended to read:

Subd. 5. "Pacakge" means the individual packet, box, or other container whatsoever used to contain and to convey cigarettes to the consumer.

CHAPTER 422—H. F. No. 1358 [Not Coded]

An act relating to certain school districts having a population of less than 2,500, an area of more than twenty-five congressional townships, and a taxable valuation of real and personal property in excess of \$1,000,000, and authorizing the issuance of bonds for the construction and betterment of school buildings and additions thereto, and the levying of taxes for the payment of such bonds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. School districts, bonds for school buildings. Any school district now or hereafter having a population of less than 2,500 according to the last federal census, and an area of more than 25 congressional townships, and a taxable valuation of real and personal property of more than \$1,000,000, may issue and sell bonds, in addition to any bonds heretofore issued, in a principal amount not exceeding \$120,000, for the purpose of construction and betterment of school buildings and additions thereto. These bonds shall be issued and sold in the manner provided by Minnesota Statutes 1953, Chapter 475. The district may levy the taxes required for the payment of such bonds plus interest thereon in excess of any existing limitations upon the tax levies of such district. The authority granted by this act shall be in addition to and not a limitation upon any other powers of the district with re-spect to the issuance and payment of bonds and the construction and betterment of school buildings and additions, and
