## CHAPTER 557—S. F. No. 683 [Not Coded]

An act to encourage industrial development declaring a policy relating thereto and authorizing the sale of certain trust fund lands in Dakota County bordering on public water.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Declaration of policy. In order to promote the further industrial development and to encourage the building of industry including barge facilities, and to encourage the further development of oil production and processing, it is declared the policy of the Legislature that the property described in Section 2 is needed for the above purpose and this act is to take care of the emergency existing and arising therefrom.
- Sec. 2. Sale of certain lands. The Commissioner of Conservation is hereby authorized to appraise and offer for sale, as provided by law, all trust fund lands owned by the State of Minnesota in Section 16, Township 115, Range 18, Dakota County, Minnesota, notwithstanding the fact that said land borders on the public waters or is subject to a flowage easement of the United States Government. Any parcel or tract of land in said Section 16, Township 115, Range 18, Dakota County, Minnesota, so sold shall be subject to any flowage easement heretofore acquired by the United States Government and shall be exempt from the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Annotated, Section 92.45, but such sale shall not abrogate or abridge any right or interest of the public in the waters bordering on or over said land.

## CHAPTER 558—S. F. No. 719

An act relating to wild animals and to the taking of frogs with the use of artificial lights; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 97.48, Subdivision 21.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 97.48, Subdivision 21, is amended to read.

Subd. 21. The commissioner may issue permits to take
