CHAPTER 628—H. F. No. 1517 [Coded]

An act relating to the powers of persons beneficially interested in trusts forming part of retirement plans for the benefit of participating members.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [501.51] Trusts forming part of retirement plans for participating members. In case of a trust forming part of a retirement plan created by and for the benefit of self-employed persons for the purpose of receiving their contributions thereunder and investing, accumulating, and distributing to such persons or their beneficiaries the corpus, profits, and earnings of the trust in accordance with the plan, the power of any person beneficially interested in such trust to sell, assign or transfer such beneficial interest, to anticipate payments thereunder, or to terminate the trust, may be limited or withheld in accordance with the provisions of the plan, whether or not he furnished consideration for the creation of the trust.

CHAPTER 629—H. F. No. 1560 [Not Coded]

An act relating to civil service in certain counties; providing for the establishment of an ungraded division within the classified service therein; amending Laws 1941, Chapter 513, Section 4, as amended, Section 5, and Section 6, as amended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1941, • Chapter 513, Section 4, as amended by Laws 1943, Chapter 259, Section 1, is amended to read:

Sec. 4. **Duties.** It shall be the duty of the county civil service commission as a body;

(a) To frame, with the assistance of the civil service administrator, and to submit to the board of county commissioners, rules and regulations for the classified service and such approval shall be given by resolution. When so approved such rules and regulations shall have the force and effect of law. Such rules may be amended and repealed with the consent
