CHAPTER 662—S. F. No. 796

An act relating to the state institution for mentally deficient at Faribault and the state institution for mentally deficient and epileptic at Cambridge, amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 252.015.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 252.015 is amended to read:

252.015 State schools and hospitals. The state institution for the mentally deficient located at Faribault shall hereafter be known and designated as the *Faribault State School and Hospital*, and the state institution for the *mentally deficient or epileptic* located at Cambridge shall hereafter be known and designated as the Cambridge State School and Hospital.

CHAPTER 663—S. F. No. 856

An act relating to the purchase of tax-forfeited lands by veterans; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 282.031.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 282.031, is amended to read:

282.031 Agricultural land, purchase by veterans. Any veteran of World War I or II or any veteran who has had active service on and after June 27, 1950, and prior to the final cessation of hostilities as proclaimed by proper federal authority, who is desirous of securing land for agricultural development may at any time prior to June 30, 1957, make application to the county board of the county in which the land is located to purchase not to exceed 200 acres of *contiguous* tax-forfeited land which has been classified as non-conservation or agri-
