Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 117.01, is amended to read:

117.01 Right of eminent domain. When the taking of private property for any public use shall be authorized by law, it may be acquired under the right of eminent domain in the manner prescribed by this chapter; but nothing herein shall apply to the taking of property under laws relating to roads and drainage, when such laws themselves expressly provide for such taking and specifically prescribe the procedure connected therewith.

The provisions of this chapter shall be considered supplementary to those provided by any municipality operating under a Home Rule Charter and shall be available to all such municipalities even though a different procedure may be provided by local charter.

CHAPTER 785—S. F. No. 1193 [Coded]

An act relating to advertising the sale of gasoline at retail for use in motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [296.023] Gasoline, tax advertised separately from price. It shall be unlawful to advertise the price of gasoline for sale at retail for use in motor vehicles, if the tax is advertised separately, unless the amount of the tax is shown in the same size type, lettering or figures as the price shown for the gasoline itself.

CHAPTER 786—S. F. No. 1197 [Coded]

An act relating to wild animals and prohibiting the setting of traps in certain areas.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [100.295] Setting of traps in certain areas.

The setting of any trap within 150 feet of any stream, lake or navigable water, within 30 days prior to the open season for trapping mink and muskrat is hereby prohibited except by special permit issued by the Commissioner.

CHAPTER 787-S. F. No. 1209

An act relating to the closing of financial institutions on certain days; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 47.015, Subdivision 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 47.015, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. Any financial institution in the state may remain closed on any Saturday and on any Monday next following a Sunday on which falls a holiday desginated by any law of this state. Any Saturday or any such Monday on which any financial institution in the state remains closed as herein permitted shall be, with respect to such financial institution, a holiday and not a business day. Any act authorized, required or permitted by law or contract to be performed on any such Saturday or on any such Monday at, by or with respect to any such financial institution remaining closed on such day may be performed on the next succeeding regular business day, and no liability or loss of rights on the part of any person or financial institution shall result from such closing.

Subd. 2. Stickers for motor vehicles. No motor vehicle shall enter or be permitted to enter any state park, memorial state park, state recreational reserve or wayside over
