

The setting of any trap within 150 feet of any stream, lake or navigable water, within 30 days prior to the open season for trapping mink and muskrat is hereby prohibited except by special permit issued by the Commissioner.

CHAPTER 787—S. F. No. 1209

An act relating to the closing of financial institutions on certain days; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 47.015, Subdivision 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 47.015, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. Any financial institution in the state may remain closed *on any Saturday and on any Monday next following a Sunday on which falls a holiday designated by any law of this state.* Any Saturday or any such Monday on which any financial institution in the state remains closed as herein permitted shall be, with respect to such financial institution, a holiday and not a business day. Any act authorized, required or permitted by law or contract to be performed on any such Saturday or on any such Monday at, by or with respect to any such financial institution remaining closed on such day may be performed on the next succeeding regular business day, and no liability or loss of rights on the part of any person or financial institution shall result from such closing.

CHAPTER 788—S. F. No. 1224

An act relating to state parks and to stickers required on motor vehicles entering same; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 85.05, Subdivision 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 85.05, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. **Stickers for motor vehicles.** No motor vehicle shall enter or be permitted to enter any *state park, memorial state park, state recreational reserve or wayside over*

50 acres in area unless it has affixed to its windshield in the lower right corner thereof a sticker which is provided for hereinafter. The commissioner of conservation shall procure stickers in such form as he shall prescribe for each calendar year which by appropriate language shall grant permission to use any state park, memorial state park, state recreational reserve or wayside over 50 acres in area. Stickers for each calendar year shall be provided and placed on sale before October 1 next preceding, and may be affixed and used on or at any time after said date until the end of calendar year for which issued. Such stickers in each category shall be numbered consecutively for each year of issue. A fee of \$1 shall be charged for each sticker issued, except that stickers or appropriate special design [designs] may be sold in lots of 25 or more to any organization at 25 cents per sticker covering the use of a specified state park, memorial state park, state recreational reserve or wayside under such conditions as the commissioner may prescribe for a designated period of not more than two days. All fees collected shall be deposited in a State Park Maintenance Fund which is hereby created in the state treasury and shall be used solely for maintenance and operation of state parks for which purposes they are hereby appropriated. Such stickers shall be issued by such employees of the Division of State Parks as the commissioner of conservation may designate in writing and as hereinafter provided.

CHAPTER 789—S. F. No. 1237

An act establishing a commission to study juvenile delinquency, crime, and corrections; and appropriating money therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Interim commission, juvenile delinquency.** A commission is created to study juvenile delinquency, crime and corrections in Minnesota, with a view toward revising and codifying existing laws and recommending improvements. The study includes but is not limited to the following:

- (a) physical plant and equipment used for correctional purposes
- (b) the types of detention—maximal, medium, and minimal
