An act relating to salaries of elected officials in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Anoka County, officer's salaries. In all counties of this state which are contiguous to a county containing a city of first class and which county has a population of 35,000 but less than 45,000 inhabitants, based on the population according to the 1950 federal census, the board of county commissioners of any county of this class, may, after having held a public hearing, notice of which hearing has been duly published setting forth the purpose of the hearing, by resolution establish that the respective county officers shall receive as compensation for services rendered by them for their respective counties, annual salaries shall not be less than \$6.500 and not in excess of as follows:

2.	County Treasurer	\$8,500
3.	Judge of Probate Court	
4.	Register of Deeds	\$8,500
5.	Sheriff	\$8,500

Sec. 2. Fees. All fees collected by the respective county officers above named shall be paid to the county and no such county officer shall receive any such fees as additional compensation.

Sec. 3. Premiums on officers' bonds. The premium
