Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 471.15, is amended to read:

471.15. Recreational facilities. Any city or any village, borough, town, county, school district, or any board thereof, or any incorporated post of the American Legion or any other incorporated veterans' organization, may operate a program of public recreation and playgrounds; acquire, equip, and maintain land, buildings, or other recreational facilities, including an outdoor or indoor swimming pool; and expend funds for the operation of such program pursuant to the provisions of Sections 471.15 to 471.19. Any such city, village, borough, town, county or school district may issue bonds pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 475 for the purpose of carrying out the powers granted by this section.

CHAPTER 118—H. F. No. 68

An act relating to aids received from the federal government, amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 128.111.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 128.111, is amended to read:

128.111. Federal moneys not chargeable against gross earnings aid. The moneys received from the federal government by any school district as its share of the distribution of proceeds from the sale of timber or rental of lands shall not be chargeable against the gross earnings aid received by the district under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1953, section 128.22 as amended by Laws 1955, Chapter 689.

CHAPTER 119-H. F. No. 200

An act relating to containers used in delivering dairy products; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 32.26.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 32.26 is amended to read:

32.26 Cans or vessels cleansed. Every person delivering milk, cream, ice cream, or other dairy product to any other person, in cans or other vessels shall have such cans or vessels free from any deleterious substance, filth, or rust, and in a wholesome condition for containing such milk, cream, ice cream, or other dairy product. Every person receiving milk, cream, ice cream, or other dairy product in cans or vessels which are to be returned to the sender or seller shall cause such cans or vessels to be promptly emptied, thoroughly cleansed, and immediately returned.

CHAPTER 120-H. F. No. 357

An act relating to terms of district courts; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 484.17.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 484.17, is amended to read:

484.17 Ninth judicial districts. General terms of district court in counties constituting the Ninth Judicial District shall be held each year at the times herein specified:

Brown County: On the second Monday in May and the first Monday following Thanksgiving Day.

Lincoln County: On the first Monday in March and the second Monday in September.

Lyon County: On the fourth Monday in April and the fourth Monday in October.

Nicollet County: On the first Monday in March and the second Monday in September.

Redwood County: On the first Monday in April and the first Monday in October.
