An act relating to salaries of county auditor and county treasurer in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Salaries, county auditor and treasurer, certain counties. In any county with a population according to the 1950 federal census of not less than 40,000 and not more than 45,000 in which a city of the second class is located, with not less than 20,000 and not more than 25,000 inhabitants, the county board may increase the annual salaries of the county auditor and county treasurer, in addition to salaries now received by them an amount not to exceed \$3,000 per annum.

CHAPTER 211—S. F. No. 777

[Coded]

An act relating to insurance and making certain minors competent to give valid release and discharge for limited amounts of life insurance proceeds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [61.66] Certain minors may receive payments of insurance benefits. Any minor domiciled in the state for whose estate there is no qualified guardianship established and who has attained the age of 18 years, determined by his nearest birthday, shall be deemed competent to receive and to give full release and discharge for a payment or payments not exceeding \$100 in any one month, made by an insurer either (a) as death benefits payable to that minor as beneficiary under one or more policies of life insurance, or (b) as proceeds of a policy on the life of that minor payable to him upon maturity of the policy as an endowment or upon surrender of the policy for its cash value. No such minor shall be deemed competent to alienate his right to, or to anticipate, such payments.
