An act authorizing the county board of certain counties to levy a tax for the county health nurse program.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. County health nurse program, tax levy. In any county containing over 75 and less than 80 full and fractional congressional townships, having an assessed valuation of over \$2,000,000 and less than \$5,000,000 and over 19,000 and less than 21,000 inhabitants according to the 1950 federal census, the county board, may levy annually a tax of not to exceed 2 mills on all the taxable property in the county, for the county health nurse program.

CHAPTER 214—S. F. No. 961

An act authorizing certain cities and villages to appropriate municipal liquor store earnings for the construction, equipment and operation of non-profit community hospitals.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Municipal liquor store earnings, appropriate portion to nonprofit hospital association. The governing body of any city or village operating an "on sale" and "off sale" municipal liquor dispensary and situated in any county having a population in excess of 24,000 but not more than 27,000 inhabitants, and having an assessed valuation in excess of \$20,000,000, but less than \$25,000,000 may appropriate annually from its liquor dispensary fund not to exceed 25 percent of the annual net earnings of such municipal liquor dispensary to any incorporated non-profit hospital association for the construction, equipment, and operation of a community hospital in any city or village in the county open to all residents of the county on equal terms.
