CHAPTER 219—S. F. No. 79

An act relating to the salary of the county auditor and county treasurer in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Salaries of county auditor and treasurer, certain counties.** In any county having an assessed valuation of more than \$20,000,000 and less than \$50,000,000, exclusive of money and credits, having over 35,000 and less than 39,000 inhabitants according to the 1950 federal census and containing less than 30 full and fractional townships, the salary of the county auditor and the county treasurer shall each be not less than \$5,000 per annum or \$6,500 per annum, to be fixed by the county board.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 1957.

CHAPTER 220—S. F. No. 715

An act relating to the adoption of ordinances by cities, villages, and boroughs, however organized; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 471.62.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 471.62, is amended to read:
