or offered for sale within this state, provided, however, that the commissioner shall have the authority to permit a retailer to sell antifreeze he has on hand which has been previously registered.

An act relating to taxation; removing the tax limitation on certain school districts; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 275.12, as amended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 275.12, as amended by Laws 1955, Chapter 645, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

[Subd. 6] This section does not apply to any special school district containing a city of the second class with a population of not less than 28,000 nor more than 30,000, according to the 1950 federal census, as of the date of enactment of this law.

CHAPTER 284-S. F. No. 955

An act relating to the incorporation of farmers' and township reinsurance or guaranty associations; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Sections 67.45, 67.48, 67.51, 67.53 and 67.54.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 67.45 is amended to read:

67.45 Mutual reinsurance or guarantee associations. Not less than six duly licensed township mutual fire insurance companies or farmers' mutual fire insurance companies may organize a mutual association for the purpose of reinsuring any part or all of any risk or risks, written by any of the member companies.
