

within the limits of the appropriations for the care of mentally ill and mentally deficient available therefor, authorize such payments as are necessary to discharge any financial obligations imposed upon this state by the compact or any agreement entered into under the compact.

Sec. 3. [245.53] **Transmittal of copies of act.** Duly authenticated copies of this act shall, upon its approval, be transmitted by the secretary of state to the governor of each state, the attorney general and the secretary of state of the United States, and the council of state governments.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1957.

CHAPTER 327—S. F. No. 472

An act to provide for a special federal census under certain circumstances in cities located in counties having over 300,000 and less than 600,000 inhabitants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Cities, special census.** Where any city has annexed territory since the 1950 federal census and it is situated in a county having over 300,000 and less than 600,000 inhabitants, the governing body of such city may at any time provide for a special census to determine the population of the city including the territory annexed. This census shall be taken by the United Census Bureau pursuant to the federal laws, rules and regulations thereunto pertaining. A report of the federal census so taken shall be obtained by the governor from the director of federal census and shall be filed with the secretary of state as provided in Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 600.18. The population of the city for all purposes shall thereafter and until the next federal decennial census, be the number so reported.

Sec. 2. **Expense authorized.** The governing body of any city authorized by this act to obtain a special census, is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into the necessary agreements with the federal director of census and to expend funds for that purpose.
