

CHAPTER 389—H. F. No. 980

An act continuing home schools for boys and girls in counties having more than 350,000 and less than 500,000 inhabitants, and in which there is a city of the first class, and providing for the operation, maintenance, construction and administration thereof, and for the cost thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. St. Paul—Ramsey, home school for boys and girls. In counties having more than 350,000 and less than 500,000 inhabitants and in which there is a city of the first class, home schools for boys and girls presently existing pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 260.14 are continued.

Sec. 2. Management vested in joint committee. The operation, maintenance, construction and administration thereof shall be exclusively under the joint committee appointed or to be appointed pursuant to Laws 1955, Chapter 353, Sec. 15.

Sec. 3. Budget, joint committee sharing equally. Such joint committee shall include a sum for the operation, maintenance, construction and administration of such schools in a budget to be timely submitted to the Board of County Commissioners of such county and the council of such city of the first class, and each shall provide one-half of the cost thereof.

Sec. 4. Powers. Such joint committee may combine or abolish either or both of such schools.

Sec. 5. Instructors, school supplies. Such city of the first class may provide necessary instructors, school books and school supplies for the boys and girls placed therein either in such home schools or in presently existing city schools as such joint committee shall determine.

Sec. 6. Placing of pupils. Except as may be herein otherwise provided, the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 260.14 and other pertinent statutes relative to the placing of boys and girls in such home schools shall remain in force and effect.

Sec. 7. Financing. The cost of the operation, maintenance, construction and administration of such schools shall be paid by such county and such city shall reimburse the county monthly for its share of such cost.
