

CHAPTER 541—H. F. No. 640

An act relating to publications in certain school districts; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 125.08, Subdivision 6.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 125.08, Subdivision 6, is amended to read:

Subd. 6. **Publication of proceedings of board.** It shall cause to be published once, in some newspaper published in such school district, or, if there be no newspaper so published therein, in some newspaper published in the county in which such school district is located, official proceedings of such board; and such publication shall be made as soon as may be and not later than 30 days after the meeting at which such proceedings were had. Such publication shall be let annually by contract to the lowest bidder at the first regular meeting of the board after the annual election in such district. The fees for publication shall not exceed the fees for publication of legal notices as prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, Section 331.08.

CHAPTER 542—H. F. No. 649

An act relating to highway traffic regulations and prohibiting juveniles from driving upon any public highway between certain hours.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [171.31] **Minor under seventeen not to drive motor vehicle between certain hours.** Any juvenile under the age of 17 is prohibited from driving a motor vehicle upon any public highway between the hours of 12:00 Midnight and 5:00 A.M., unless accompanied by an adult or in the case of an emergency.

Sec. 2. [171.32] **Violations.** Every juvenile who violates this act shall have his driver's license suspended for 30 days. Upon a second violation he shall have his driver's license suspended for 60 days. Upon a subsequent violation of this act, such juvenile shall have his driver's license revoked
