

## CHAPTER 617—H. F. No. 1825

*An act relating to game and fish; empowering certain department of conservation personnel to enforce laws relating to wild rice, public waters, state dams and works, water pollution, and conservation; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 97.50, Subdivision 1.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 97.50, Subdivision 1, is hereby amended to read:

**97.50 Police powers.** Subdivision 1. The commissioner, director, game refuge patrolmen, and game wardens are hereby authorized and empowered to execute and serve all warrants and processes issued by any justice of the peace or magistrate or by any court having jurisdiction under any law relating to wild animals, *wild rice, use of water, conservation, protection or control of public waters, state-owned dams or other works affecting public waters or water pollution*, in the same manner as any constable or sheriff may do so, and to arrest, without a warrant, any person detected in the actual violation of any provisions of chapters 84, 97 to 102, 105 and 106, and to take such person before any court in the county in which the offense was committed and make proper complaint.

CHAPTER 618—H. F. No. 1827

*An act relating to certain defects in proceedings had by counties in the sale of real estate.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [373.013] **Certain county conveyances not invalid.** No deed of conveyance of real estate executed by a county prior to July 1, 1952 shall be held invalid or void for failure to comply with requirements of Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 373.01, relating to the resolution of the county board or notice of hearing thereon or publication thereof.
