shall be taxed annually at the rate of 10 cents per acre. This tax shall be levied and collected and the payment thereof, with penalties and interest, enforced in the same manner as other taxes on real estate, and shall be credited to the funds of the taxing districts affected in the proportion of their interests in the taxes on this land if it had not been so made an auxiliary forest; provided, that such tax shall be due in full on or before May 31, after the levy thereof. Failure to pay when due any tax so levied shall be cause for cancellation of the contract.

The levy upon the land of the taxes provided for by section 88.49, subdivision 5, upon the cancellation of a contract, shall discharge and annul all unpaid taxes levied or assessed thereon.

An act relating to salaries of certain officers in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Salaries, county officers. In all counties of this state having not less than 50 nor more than 60 full or fractional congressional townships, and having a land area of not less than 1,700, nor more than 2,000 square miles, the annual salaries of the county officers named herein shall be as follows:
