Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1955, Chapter 569, Section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. Minneapolis municipal court, salaries of court reporters. The salary of the court reporters of the municipal court in each city having not less than 450,000 inhabitants is \$6,800 per annum payable in semi-monthly installments by the city treasurer of the city.

The provisions of this section shall be retroactive to January 1, 1957, and shall expire June 30, 1959.

CHAPTER 799—S. F. No. 1878

An act fixing the compensation of members of the board of estimate and taxation in any city now or hereafter having a population in excess of 450,000.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minneapolis, compensation of members of board of estimate and taxation. Notwithstanding the provisions of any city charter to the contrary, the members of the board of estimate and taxation except those receiving other compensation in excess of \$10,000 from the city, of any city now or hereafter having a population in excess of 450,000, shall receive \$20 per diem but not to exceed \$1,000 per year as full compensation for their services on the board.
