CHAPTER 84—H. F. No. 40

An act relating to elections; amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 206.12.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 206.12, is amended to read :

206.12 Certificate of registered voters. In all municipal corporations operating under a permanent registration system, before any person offering to vote receives the ballots from the judges, a certificate containing the following information shall be signed by the applicant :

I hereby certify that I am a qualified voter, permanently registered in accordance with the provisions of Part Two of the Minnesota Election Law.

(Signature of voter)

(Address)

Approved

(Judge) (Clerk) of Election

The certificate shall be approved by a judge or clerk and then handed to the voter who shall deliver it to the judge in charge of ballots as proof of his right to vote. The certificates shall be arranged in alphabetical order and returned to the clerk of the municipal corporation after the close of the election in envelopes provided for the return of the ballots.

Sec. 2. This act will become effective on July 1, 1957.
