## CHAPTER 128—S. F. No. 801

An act relating to cooperative marketing associations; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 22.09.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 22.09, is amended to read:

22.09Amendment of articles of incorporation. articles of incorporation may be altered or amended at any regular meeting of members or stockholders or at any special meeting called for that purpose where a quorum is registered as being present. An amendment must first be approved by two-thirds of the directors and a copy of the text of the proposed amendment shall be mailed to each member or stockholder not less than ten days prior to the meeting or published in the same manner as publication of notice of meetings of members or stockholders, and the same must be approved by a vote representing a majority of the members or stockholders present at the meeting. After an amendment has been adopted by the stockholders, articles of amendment setting forth the amendment and the manner of adoption thereof shall be signed and acknowledged by the president or vice-president and by the secretary or assistant secretary, and shall be filed in accordance with the provisions of original filing.

## CHAPTER 129-S. F. No. 851

An act relating to the harvesting of wild rice grain in the public waters of the State of Minnesota, amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 84.14.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 84.14, is amended to read:

84.14 Director of wild rice harvest. [Subdivision 1.] The commissioner may appoint a director of the wild rice harvest, who shall be a man of proven experience in the actual cultivation and harvesting of wild rice, and such assistants as may be deemed necessary. The director shall serve at the will of the commissioner and shall not be within the classified service of the state. He may be paid such salary, not to exceed the sum of \$250 a month, as may be determined by the com-
