lage so long as the dead of the village are buried in the cemetery.

Sec. 3. The authority granted by this act is in addition to the authority otherwise granted by law to towns in relation to cemeteries.

Sec. 4. This act takes effect when approved by a majority of the governing body of the town of Grand Rapids.

## CHAPTER 299-S. F. No. 1137

An act authorizing the sale of certain state owned land.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Sale of state land. The commissioner of conservation is hereby authorized to approve for sale at public auction the following described tax-forfeited land in the Aitkin County conservation area, if it is classified by the county board as suitable for agriculture, notwithstanding the fact that it borders on public waters:

Lot three (3), section eleven (11), township fortyeight (48), range twenty-seven (27), Aitkin County, Minnesota, consisting of 58.40 acres, more or less.

## CHAPTER 300-S. F. No. 1207

An act establishing general terms of district court in the twelfth judicial district; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 484.16.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 484.16, is amended to read:

484.16 Carver and other counties. General terms of district court in the counties constituting the *twelfth* judicial district shall be held each year at the times herein specified:

Carver County: On the last Monday in February and the second Monday in October.

Le Sueur County: On the first Monday in April and the first Tuesday in September.

McLeod County: On the first Monday in November and the second Monday in May.

Scott County: On the second Monday in May and the second Monday in November.

Sibley County: On the third Monday in September and the first Monday in March.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1959.

## CHAPTER 301-S. F. No. 1211

## [Not Coded]

An act relating to the payment of auto mileage to county commissioners of St. Louis County for use of their private cars.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Automobile expense of commissioners. County commissioners of St. Louis county are hereby authorized to pay themselves when they submit a certified claim to the board, for the use of their privately owned cars used in county business at the rate permitted by law, from the road and bridge fund of their respective districts, and said payments shall be over and above their general expenses for county business authorized by Laws 1951, Chapter 391, Section 2, but not to exceed in any one calendar year the sum of \$1200 for each commissioner.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective after its approval by a majority vote of the board of county commissioners of St. Louis county.
