An act relating to salaries of county commissioners in the County of Itasca.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Itasca County, commissioner's salaries. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law to the contrary, each member of the board of county commissioners of the county of Itasca shall receive a monthly salary of \$315 payable on the first day of each calendar month as the salaries of other county officials are paid.
- Sec. 2. The aforesaid salary shall constitute a base salary; the board of county commissioners, if they so elect, may increase such salaries on the basis of the cost of living salary adjustment as provided in Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 375.43 and acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto.
- Sec. 3. This act shall become effective upon approval by a majority of the governing body of the county of Itasca.

CHAPTER 353—S. F. No. 727

An act relating to bail, authorizing certain magistrates in certain cases to provide a bail schedule and to designate persons to receive such bail in their absence.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. [629.71] Schedules setting bail. [Subdivision 1.] Any magistrate, having jurisdiction over any offenses constituting misdemeanors committed in violation of Chapter 169 or Chapters 97 through 102, or any municipal ordinance, may, by order, provide a schedule of bail setting forth the amount of bail required to be deposited by an accused in order to obtain release from custody.
- Sec. 2. [Subd. 2.] Any magistrate may designate any person or persons to receive the bail as provided in the bail schedule when the court over which the magistrate presides is not in session or when the magistrate is not available.

Sec. 3. [Subd. 3.] A copy of the order and schedule of bail shall be filed by the magistrate with the clerk of the district court of the county in which the magistrate presides.

CHAPTER 354—S. F. No. 1086

An act relating to the examiner of titles of St. Louis County.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. St. Louis County, examiner of titles. Not-withstanding the provisions of any other law to the contrary, the judges of the district court of St. Louis county, as part of the compensation of any examiner of titles who has held the office of examiner of titles continuously for a period of not less than 30 years and has passed the age of 70 years or has in the opinion of the judges become incompetent to further discharge the duties of his office, may, with the approval of the county board, order that such examiner of titles shall be paid monthly out of the St. Louis county general fund, upon his retirement from office and during the remainder of his natural life, such sum as the judges may order and the county board approves.
- Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon its approval by the county board of St. Louis county.
