

Section 1. Carlton County, court house, business hours. The board of county commissioners of Carlton county may by resolution close the county court house or houses and the public offices therein on Saturdays and Sundays of each week. In the event the offices of the county are so closed, any and all business that might otherwise be transacted with any such offices on any such Saturday, including the payment of taxes, may be performed on the next succeeding legal business day without penalty or any loss of personal or property rights.

Sec. 2. This law is effective after its approval by a majority of the board of county commissioners of such county.

CHAPTER 391—H. F. No. 1684

[Not Coded]

An act relating to Itasca County; mileage allowance for certain county employees.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Itasca County, mileage allowances. The county board of Itasca county may allow mileage, not to exceed ten cents per mile to any county employee whose duties cause undue or excessive wear to the motor vehicle operated by the employee.

Sec. 2. This act takes effect when approved by a majority of the county board of Itasca county.

CHAPTER 392—H. F. No. 1799

[Not Coded]

An act authorizing the sale of certain state owned property at public sale to the highest responsible bidder.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Sale of state land, Stearns County. The commissioner of administration may sell at public sale, after competitive bidding, all the real estate owned by the state of

Minnesota and situated in the county of Stearns and described as follows:

All that portion of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Two (2), Township One Hundred Twenty-six (126), Range Thirty-four (34) bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter (SW corner NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Two (2), thence running east on the south line of said quarter section 156.5 feet, thence northerly and westerly 236.6 feet more or less to a point on the west line of said Section Two (2) aforesaid, 177.3 feet from the place of beginning, thence south on the west line of said Section Two (2), 177.3 feet to the place of beginning, containing 32/100 acres more or less.

Sec. 2. Such sale shall be had after publication of notice of such sale in a newspaper of general circulation at least once during two successive weeks and a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the real estate is situated. Sale shall be made for cash to the highest responsible bidder at public sale, after competitive bidding.

Sec. 3. The governor upon the recommendation of the commissioner of administration shall deliver to the successful bidder a quit claim deed covering the real estate sold to him in such form as the attorney general shall prescribe.

CHAPTER 393—S. F. No. 327

[Coded]

An act authorizing county officials to close their offices on Saturdays and providing for performance of acts authorized, required or permitted by law or contract to be performed on the next succeeding regular business day.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [373.052] County offices; closing, effect. [Subdivision 1.] The county officials of any county may, with the consent of the county board, provide for the closing of their respective county offices on any and all Saturdays.
