

outstanding revenue bonds theretofore issued by said board under said sections and (b) for acquiring, constructing, completing, remodeling or equipping structures to be used for dormitory, residence hall, or food service purposes at the Mankato, St. Cloud, Winona, Moorhead and Bemidji Colleges, including acquisition of any sites needed therefor.

Subd. 2. Such board or successor is authorized to issue additional revenue bonds under the law mentioned in subdivision 1, and payable solely from the revenue appropriated thereto by said law, in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$6,000,000, and to use the proceeds of their sale for acquiring, constructing, completing, remodeling, or equipping structures to be used for dormitory, residence hall, or food service purposes at any of the state colleges, including acquisition of any sites needed therefor.

CHAPTER 414—H. F. No. 876

An act relating to sheriffs and deputy sheriffs; providing for a uniform and equipment allowance therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [387.211] **Uniform and equipment allowance.** An allowance for the purchase and maintenance of uniforms and equipment for sheriffs and full time deputy sheriffs may be allowed in each county in such amounts and at such times as the board of county commissioners may set.
