EXTRA SESSION:

CHAPTER 29—H. F. No. 89

An act relating to the salaries of supervisors, clerk, treasurer, and assessor in the Town of Stuntz; amending Laws 1955, Chapter 511, Sections 1 and 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1955, Chapter 511, Section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. **Stuntz, town of, officials' salaries.** *In the town of Stuntz the monthly salary of each member of the board of supervisors shall not exceed the sum of \$250, but the board of supervisors by resolution may pay an additional \$50 per month to the chairman of the board.*

Sec. 2. Laws 1955, Chapter 511, Section 2, is amended to read:

Sec. 2. The board of supervisors of the town of *Stuntz* shall fix a monthly salary to be paid by the town to the town clerk, the town treasurer, and assessor which shall be in such amount as the board shall deem reasonable and proper. This compensation shall be paid in lieu of any amounts otherwise provided by law to be paid to them by the town.

Sec. 3. *This act takes effect only after its approval by a resolution adopted by a majority vote of the town board at a regular meeting thereof held within six months of the passage of this act and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368, or after its approval by a majority vote of the voters voting at a referendum submitting the question at the next annual election following the passage of this act and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.*

EXTRA SESSION

CHAPTER 30—H. F. No. 106

An act relating to salaries of certain officials in Aitkin County.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **County commissioners and county attorney, salaries.** The annual salaries of county commissioners and county attorney shall be in such amount as may be fixed by the county board but not to exceed the following amounts, said sums to be paid monthly.

County commissioners	\$1,800
County attorney	\$4,200
