CHAPTER 32—H. F. No. 145

An act relating to Clearwater County; authorizing the county board to levy taxes to provide aid to the county agricultural society.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Clearwater County, agricultural society tax levy.** Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law to the contrary, the county board of Clearwater county, in addition to all other powers now or hereafter by law conferred upon county boards, may annually levy a tax of not to exceed two mills upon all property subject to taxation and, from time to time, appropriate and pay over the proceeds of this tax, when collected, to the county agricultural society of its county, to assist the society in paying its financial obligations now or hereafter incurred, and for the construction, reconstruction, alteration, repairs, and improvements of necessary buildings.

Sec. 2. This act takes effect when approved by a majority of the county board of Clearwater county and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

EXTRA SESSION

CHAPTER 33—H. F. No. 146

[Not Coded]

An act relating to compensation of certain officials in Olmsted County and the number of deputies and clerks for such offices and their compensation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Olmsted County officers' salaries. The county of Olmsted shall pay to each county official designated in this section as full compensation for all services rendered by them, annual salaries to be determined by the board of county commissioners, but not to exceed the amounts herein specified as to each official. The officials and the amounts specified are as follows:

1. County auditor	\$ 9,500
2. County treasurer.....	9,500
3. Sheriff	12,500
4. Clerk of district court	9,500
5. Register of deeds and registrar of titles, being one office	9,500

Sec. 2. All fees collected by the county officials named in section 1 shall be paid to the county in the manner and at the times prescribed by the county board, and no such official shall receive any such fees as additional compensation.

Sec. 3. The board of county commissioners shall by resolution determine the number of deputies assigned to each office, and the number of clerks and other employees required in the performance of each respective office, and shall determine and provide for the compensation of each.

Sec. 4. In addition to the salaries and compensation to be paid officials, deputies, clerks, and employees as provided in this act, the board of county commissioners shall by resolution provide for the payment of premiums of any bonds required of any official, deputy, clerk, or employee designated in this act.

Sec. 5. This act as to compensation of the register of deeds takes effect immediately upon its effective date. This act takes effect as to compensation of the clerk of district court on January 1, 1961, and as to the auditor, treasurer, and sheriff on January 1, 1963.

Sec. 6. All laws now in force relating to compensation or fees of the county officials named in this act inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and superseded.

Sec. 7. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the board of county commissioners of Olmsted county, and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.
