

Sec. 14. **Application.** Sections 1 to 15 shall not apply and shall have no force or effect upon the county until the requirements and procedure for creation of a sheriff's civil service commission as herein outlined have been complied with.

Sec. 15. **Veterans preference law not affected.** Section 1 to 15 do not exclude or modify the application of Minnesota Statutes, Sections 197.45 and 197.46, known as the Veterans Preference Law.

Sec. 16. Sections 1 to 15 shall be effective upon approval by a majority vote of the members of the Board of County Commissioners and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

#### CHAPTER 155—S. F. No. 488

*An act relating to clerk hire in county offices in any county having not less than 13 full and fractional congressional townships and having an area of not less than 400 nor more than 410 square miles; repealing Laws 1939, Chapter 247.*

Section 1. Laws 1939, Chapter 247, is hereby repealed.
