CHAPTER 158—S. F. No. 825

An act authorizing the county of Wabasha to levy tax for county road and bridge fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **County of Wabasha, road and bridge tax levy.** The board of county commissioners of the county of Wabasha may levy a tax not to exceed 25 mills on the dollar of the taxable valuation of the county for the county road and bridge fund.

Sec. 2. **Effective date.** This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the board of county commissioners of the county of Wabasha, and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.
