## CHAPTER 184-S. F. No. 98

An act relating to the furnishing of police service to any contracting municipality located in Scott county by the sheriff of Scott county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Scott county municipalities, police protection. Any village, city, borough, or township in the county of Scott may contract with the sheriff of Scott county to provide the policing of the village, city, borough, or township through the use of equipment and personnel of the sheriff. Any such contract with the sheriff of Scott county shall be approved by the board of county commissioners of Scott county.

Sec. 2. Contracts with sheriff. The contracts provided for in Section 1 shall comply with Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 471.59, and may provide that all or part of the police powers and duties of village, city, borough or township police officers are to be performed by personnel of the contracting party.

Sec. 3. Sheriff to exercise police powers. Under such a contract a person employed by the sheriff may be empowered to exercise all of the police powers and duties of a municipal police officer but he shall not by reason thereof be classified as a municipal employee for any purpose other than the discharge of such powers and duties.

Sec. 4. **Duties of sheriff.** The sheriff shall not, by virtue of this act, be relieved of any duties imposed upon him or his office by law.

Sec. 5. This act shall become effective only after its approval by the majority of the board of commissioners of Scott county and shall become effective as to any city, village or borough in Scott county only after its approval by a majority of the members of the governing body of such city, village or borough and shall become effective as to any township in Scott county only after its approval by a majority of the members of the town board of such township.

Sec. 6. This act shall be subject to the provisions of Chapter 368, Laws of 1959.
