CHAPTER 22—S. F. No. 99

An act relating to the salary of the city treasurer of the city of South Saint Paul.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **South St. Paul, treasurer's salary.** The council of the city of South Saint Paul may, by a majority vote of all its members, fix a rate of compensation to be paid the city treasurer which shall be paid in addition to compensation now authorized by any home rule charter, in order to provide any adjustment needed because of increased costs of living.

Sec. 2. **Effective date.** This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the council of the city of South Saint Paul and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

CHAPTER 23—S. F. No. 139

An act relating to the salary of the city assessor of the city of South Saint Paul.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **South St. Paul, assessor's salary.** The council of the city of South Saint Paul may, by majority vote of all of its members, fix and determine the salary of the city assessor and appropriate money for the payment of such salary as so determined, and define his duties.

Sec. 2. **Effective date.** This act shall become effective

CHAPTER 24—S. F. No. 160

An act relating to South Saint Paul; providing for salaries for the mayor and councilmen thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. South St. Paul, mayor and councilmen, salaries. The council of the city of South Saint Paul shall fix the salary of the mayor at \$1200 per year and the salary of each councilman at \$600 per year, said salaries to be paid in equal monthly installments.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the council of the city of South Saint Paul and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

CHAPTER 25—S. F. No. 259

An act relating to intoxicating liquors and non-intoxicating malt liquors; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 340.07, Subdivision 5.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 340.07, Subdivision 5, is amended to read:

340.07 Subdivision 5. Liquor stores, sale of ice. "Exclusive liquor store" is an establishment used exclusively for the sale of intoxicating liquor, cigars, cigarettes, *ice*, all forms of tobacco, non-intoxicating malt beverages and soft drinks at retail, either on sale or off sale, or both; provided, that lunches may be sold in a liquor store located in a village containing less than 500 inhabitants and situated in any coun-

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
