CHAPTER 242—S. F. No. 555

*An act providing that the city of Winona may expend money for advertising and promoting the city.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Winona, city of, expenditures for advertising.** Notwithstanding any other law, the city of Winona may expend \$2,500 annually for advertising and promoting said city.

Sec. 2. This act shall be effective and in force only until June 1, 1965. R'63

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the governing body of the city of Winona and upon compliance with the provisions of Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

CHAPTER 243—S. F. No. 618

*An act relating to real estate taxes; providing for homestead exemption for property owned by a member of the armed forces; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 273.13, Subdivision 10.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 273.13, Subdivision 10, is amended to read:

Subd. 10. **Homestead of member of U. S. armed forces in class 3B or 3C.** Real estate actually occupied and used for the purpose of a homestead by ~~any person entering the service~~ *a member* of the armed forces of the United States,
