feeding and resting area during the open migratory waterfowl season with any boat propelled by a motor with any kind of motor propelled boat, raft, watercraft or aircraft.

## CHAPTER 242—S. F. No. 555

## [Not Coded]

An act providing that the city of Winona may expend money for advertising and promoting the city.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Winona, city of, expenditures for advertising. Notwithstanding any other law, the city of Winona may expend \$2,500 annually for advertising and promoting said city.
- Sec. 2. This act shall be effective and in force only  $\mathcal{R}^{63}_{C5}$  until June 1, 1965.
- Sec. 3. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the governing body of the city of Winona and upon compliance with the provisions of Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

An act relating to real estate taxes; providing for homestead exemption for property owned by a member of the armed forces; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 273.13, Subdivision 10.

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 273.13, Subdivision 10, is amended to read:
- Subd. 10. Homestead of member of U. S. armed forces in class 3B or 3C. Real estate actually occupied and used for the purpose of a homestead by any person entering the service a member of the armed forces of the United States,
