An act relating to the village of Aurora, authorizing expenditures of certain funds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Aurora, village of; hospital donations. Notwithstanding any provision in Laws 1955, Chapter 579 and Laws 1959, Chapter 424 to the contrary, the balance of any money, obtained from the sale of bonds to construct and equip a community building for recreational purposes, remaining, after the expenditures for the village fire hall, may be donated to the White Community Hospital Corporation, a non-profit corporation for the operation and maintenance of such hospital.
- Sec. 2. This act shall be effective upon its approval by four-fifths of the members of the governing body of the village of Aurora.

An act relating to wild animals; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 97.48.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 97.48, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:
- [Subd. 24.] The commissioner may limit the number of persons who may hunt deer by means of firearm on any game refuge or public hunting ground, when he determines that the game supply or area open to hunting is too small for unrestricted hunting, and he may establish by order any practicable method, including a drawing, for impartially determining the persons who may hunt in such areas.
