

CHAPTER 295—H. F. No. 778

An act relating to firemen's relief association and firemen's pensions, and pensions to their families in the city of Cloquet; amending Laws 1941, Chapter 196, Section 1, as amended, and Section 6, as amended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1941, Chapter 196, Section 1, Subdivision 1, as amended by Laws 1955, Chapter 42, Section 1, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. **Firemen, pensions, Cloquet.** Subdivision 1. In any *the* city of the fourth class situated in a county having not less than 24,000 nor more than 26,000 inhabitants, and having an assessed valuation of not less than \$10,000,000 nor more than \$14,000,000, exclusive of money and credits, and containing not less than 550,000 nor more than 552,000 acres; and Cloquet having a Firemen's Relief Association, such association shall pay retirement pensions as set forth in the following subdivisions.

Sec. 2. Laws 1941, Chapter 196, Section 6, as amended by Laws 1953, Chapter 253, Section 2, is amended to read:

Sec. 6. **Tax levy, when omitted.** If at any time the balance on hand of the fund so raised by taxation as in this section provided, together with other resources in said special fund, shall exceed ~~\$100,000~~ \$150,000, then as often as this occurs, the levy of said sum shall be omitted for any year in which said condition exists; if at any time the whole amount of the sums that may be raised by taxation in any year is not needed for the purposes of this act and the maintenance of said fund at the amount prescribed herein, then such sum so to be raised by taxation in any such year shall be proportionately reduced to such amount as will be sufficient to carry out the provisions hereof.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the governing body of the city of Cloquet and upon compliance with the provisions of Laws 1959, Chapter 368.
