The annual salary of the judge of the municipal court of Faribault is \$6500, and the annual salary of the judge of the municipal court of Northfield is \$1900, notwithstanding the provisions of Laws 1959, Chapter 691, Section 1, Subdivision 2. The salaries herein provided do not include the additional compensation as judge of conciliation court.

Sec. 2. [482.35] Faribault and Northfield municipal court. The revisor of statutes in compiling the next edition of the Minnesota Statutes shall substitute the salaries fixed in section 1 hereof for the salaries specified for each judge in Laws 1959, Chapter 691, Section 1, Subdivision 2.

The governor shall appoint a state board of ehiropody podiatry examiners and registration consisting of five members who shall be resident ehiropodists podiatrists of good standing in their profession; each member shall serve five years and until his successor is appointed and has qualified.
- Sec. 2. [482.36] Chiropody, change of term to podiatry. The revisor of statutes shall strike the word chiropody and insert in lieu thereof the word podiatry, and shall strike the word chiropodist and insert in lieu thereof the word podiatrist, wherever such words appear in Minnesota Statutes 1957, Sections 153.01 to 153.15, except Laws 1959, Chapter 70, Section 1.

This section shall be effective upon approval by a majority of the members of the city council of the city of Columbia Heights, and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368, and shall expire upon adoption of a charter amendment which sets salaries in excess of those provided in subdivision 1.
