The governor shall appoint a state board of ~~chiropractic~~ *podiatry* examiners and registration consisting of five members who shall be resident ~~chiropractors~~ *podiatrists* of good standing in their profession; each member shall serve five years and until his successor is appointed and has qualified.

Sec. 2. [482.36] **Chiropractic, change of term to podiatry.** *The revisor of statutes shall strike the word chiropractic and insert in lieu thereof the word podiatry, and shall strike the word chiropractor and insert in lieu thereof the word podiatrist, wherever such words appear in Minnesota Statutes 1957, Sections 153.01 to 153.15, except Laws 1959, Chapter 70, Section 1.*

CHAPTER 370—H. F. No. 1511

An act relating to the salaries of the mayor and aldermen of the city of Columbia Heights.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Columbia Heights, city of; officials' salaries.** Subdivision 1. The annual salary of the mayor of the city of Columbia Heights shall be \$1200, and the annual salary of each alderman shall be \$900. Such salaries shall be paid in equal monthly installments.

Subd. 2. This section shall be effective upon approval by a majority of the members of the city council of the city of Columbia Heights, and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368, and shall expire upon adoption of a charter amendment which sets salaries in excess of those provided in subdivision 1.
