hereafter of any amendment to the charter of the city of Saint Paul increasing or decreasing any such salaries.

Sec. 4. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the governing body of the city of Saint Paul, Ramsey county, and upon compliance with the provisions of Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

## CHAPTER 545-S. F. No. 1644

[Not Coded]

An act relating to the port authority of the city of Saint Paul, providing therefor and authorizing said port authority to provide for a treasurer's bond in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 and an assistant treasurer's bond in an amount not to exceed \$10,000, the amount of such bonds to be determined at least annually by said port authority.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. St. Paul port authority; treasurer and assistant treasurer; bond. Notwithstanding inconsistent provisions of any other statute, the treasurer and assistant treasurer of the port authority of the city of Saint Paul shall give bond to the state in sums not to exceed \$25,000 and \$10,000 respectively, such bonds to be conditioned for the faithful discharge of their duties and to be approved as to both form and surety by said port authority and filed with its secretary. The amount of such bonds shall be determined at least annually by the port authority.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the members of the port authority of the city of Saint Paul and by a majority of the governing body of the city of Saint Paul and upon compliance with the provisions of Laws 1959, Chapter 368.
