## CHAPTER 63—S. F. No. 177

An act relating to the city of Rochester, ratifying, validating, and authorizing proceedings taken and contracts, agreements, appropriations, and expenditures made for the acquisition, establishment, enlargement, improvement, maintenance, equipment, operation, management, and regulation of its municipal airport and air navigation facilities, structures, and other property incidental to the operation thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Rochester, municipal airport, validating. Section 1. All proceedings heretofore taken by the city of Rochester, its common council, and officers precedent to and in the acquisition, establishment, construction, enlargement, and improvement of its municipal airport situated in sections 4, 9, 10, 14, 15, and 16, township 105 north, range 14 west, Olmsted county, Minnesota, and of air navigation facilities and structures and other property incidental to the operation of said airport, and all contracts, agreements, appropriations, and expenditures heretofore made by authority of said council, for the acquisition, establishment, construction, enlargement, improvement, maintenance, equipment, operation, management, and regulation of such airport, air navigation facilities, structures, and other property, and all parts thereof, are hereby ratified, validated, and authorized, and all such contracts and agreements are declared to be valid and binding upon and enforceable by the parties thereto in accordance with their terms, notwithstanding any pre-existing lack of power under the home rule charter of the city or the laws of the state to make or comply with the provisions therein contained or to take the actions therein authorized, and notwithstanding any defect, other than constitutional, in such proceedings, and notwithstanding any prohibition, other than constitutional, against the making of, or compliance with any such provision or the taking of any such action on the part of the city or of any other party to such contracts and agreements.

Sec. 2. Nothing herein is intended to impair any of the rights, privileges, and immunities granted to the city of Rochester and its officers, agents, servants, and employees by the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1957, sections 360.033 and 360.035, and no provision of any contract or agreement having such effect is validated hereby or shall have any

force or effect; but no such provision in any contract or agreement which is mutually agreed by the parties thereto to be separable from the remaining provisions thereof shall affect the validity and enforceability of such remaining provisions.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective upon its approval by resolution duly adopted by the common council of the city of Rochester, by the vote of not less than a majority of all its members, and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

## CHAPTER 64-S. F. No. 198

An act relating to drivers licenses; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 171.22, and providing penalties for violations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 171.22, is amended to read:
- 171.22 Unlawful acts, drivers license. It shall be unlawful for any person:
- (1) To display, or cause or permit to be displayed, or have in his possession, any canceled, revoked, suspended, fictitious, or fraudulently altered driver's license; or
- (2) To lend his driver's license to any other person or knowingly permit the use thereof by another; or
- (3) To display or represent as one's own any driver's license not issued to him; or
- (4) To fail or refuse to surrender to the department, upon its lawful demand, any driver's license which has been suspended, revoked, or canceled; or
- (5) To use a false or fictitious name in any application for a driver's license, or to knowingly make a false statement, or to knowingly conceal a material fact, or otherwise commit a fraud in any such application; or
- (6) To alter any driver's license, or to counterfeit or make any fictitious license; or
